- Make parking downtown more expensive so people would be more likely to take the bus.

- Transportation master plan is to add lanes to Circle Drive just puts more care on the roads and you get more congestion.
- Toronto \$350 month for parking 25 years ago... easier to take transit –
 should make parking more expensive downtown here
- Provincial agenda is to promote oil and gas industry
